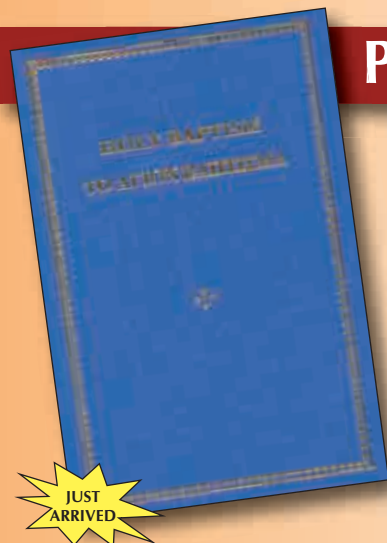

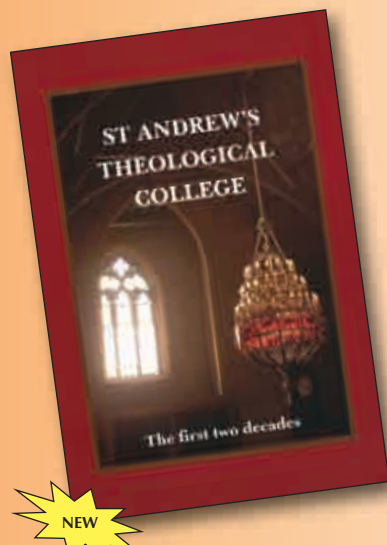

### HOLY BAPTISM

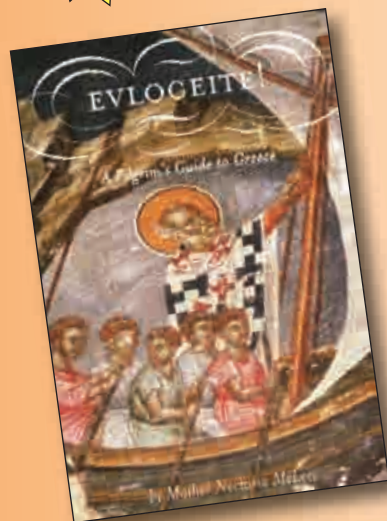

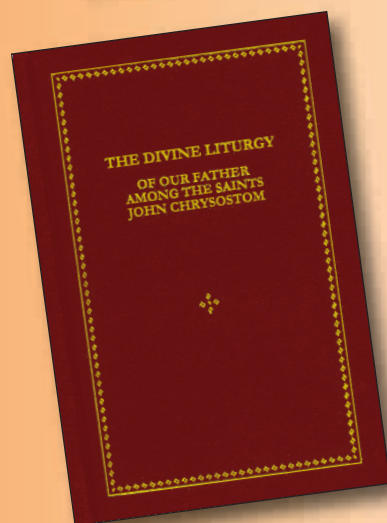
### ST ANDREW'S THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE - THE FIRST TWO DECADES

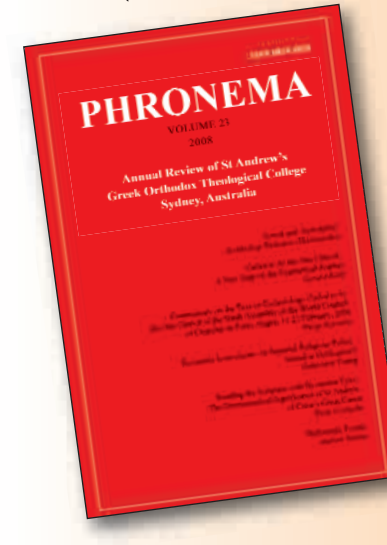
